

Topi-Click Ear Gel for Pets

inner ear flap — never the ear canal

Some pet medications can be compounded as a **transdermal gel** — absorbed through the thin, hairless skin inside the ear — so there's no pill, no liquid, no fight. Your pet's dose comes in a **Topi-Click dosing pen** that measures each dose in "clicks." Follow your veterinarian's directions and the prescription label first.

Where it goes — the inner ear pinna

The gel is applied to the **inner surface of the pinna** — the smooth, hairless skin on the inside of the ear flap. That skin is thin, with good blood flow, so the medication absorbs through it.

- **Right spot:** the hairless inner face of the ear flap, toward the tip — **not** down inside the ear canal.
- **Alternate ears:** left ear one dose, right ear the next. It keeps the skin from getting irritated.

Protect yourself — wear gloves.

Transdermal medication absorbs through **your** skin too. Always wear a disposable glove or finger cot to apply it, wash your hands after, and don't let children or anyone pregnant or nursing touch the pet's ear after dosing. Ask us about your specific medication's precautions.

How to apply it

1. **Put on a disposable glove** or finger cot.
2. **Prime a new pen** if we've instructed you to; then turn the base to dispense your pet's prescribed **number of clicks** onto your gloved fingertip.
3. **Hold the ear flap gently** and spread the gel in a **thin, even layer** over the hairless inner surface. Rub softly for a few seconds so it absorbs.
4. **Give a treat**, and keep your pet from shaking or scratching for a minute or two.
5. **Remove the glove inside-out**, throw it away, and wash your hands.
6. **Next dose, use the other ear.** About once a week, wipe the ears gently with a damp cloth or baby wipe to remove any residue buildup before the next dose.

Good to know

- **Missed dose?** Give it when you remember unless it's close to the next one — never double up. Ask us if unsure.
- **Watch the ear.** Mild pinkness can happen; tell your vet about redness, sores, scratching, or head-shaking.
- **Storage.** Store the pen as your label directs, away from children and other pets.
- **It's still real medicine.** Keep vet-recheck and lab appointments so the dose can be adjusted based on how your pet responds.
